## Admission Procedure

### Introduction

All India Ayush Post Graduate Entrance Test 2018 (AIA-PGET-2018) has conducted by All India Institute of Ayurved, Delhi (AIIA) on behalf of Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India.

The admissions to MD/MS course shall be done on the basis of AIA-PGET-2018 ranking.

- The eligible candidate will apply online through the admission portal of Vidyapeeth for the PG (MD/MS) Course - [admissions.dpu.edu.in](http://admissions.dpu.edu.in)
- The application of eligible candidates will be accepted after a processing fee of Rs. 500/- is paid during online submission of the application.
- Once applications of eligible candidates are received, a merit list will be displayed on the college website: [ayurved.dypvp.edu.in](http://ayurved.dypvp.edu.in)
- Candidates whose name has been displayed in the merit list on the website are required to be present for counselling in stipulated time otherwise it is considered that applicant is not interested in the admission.

### Certificates / Documents to be brought on the day of counselling for admission.

- Nationality certificate issued by District Magistrate/Addl. District Magistrate or Metropolitan Magistrate (Competent Authority for issue of such certificate)/ valid Indian passport /School Leaving Certificate of HSC/12th Std. indicating the nationality of the candidate as 'Indian'.
- S.S.C. (or equivalent) passing certificate (for Date of Birth)
- BAMS Passing / Degree Certificate
- Internship Completion Certificate on/or before the Counselling
- Permanent or Provisional Registration Certificate
- College Leaving Certificate
- Medical fitness Certificate
- Aadhaar Card & Pan Card
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- Caste Validity Certificate (if applicable)
- Non-creamy layer Certificate (if applicable)
- Gap affidavit (if applicable)
- For Person with disability (PWD) Candidates - Medical Fitness Certificate of Authorized Medical Board.

### Eligibility

- Indian Nationals, Non Resident Indians (NRI's), Overseas Citizen of Indian (OCI's), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO's) & Foreign Nationals are eligible for appearing in the AIA-PGET 2018 (All India Ayush Post Graduate Entrance Test)
- The candidate must have passed the qualifying examination i.e. BAMS Passing / Degree Certificate
- The applicant should complete his / her rotating internship training before the commencement of counselling and spot admission that is by 2018.
- The candidate should possess a permanent registration with any State Medical Council in India or Central Council of Indian Medicine. If he does not have the same he will be required to obtain such registration within one month after admission to the PG course, failing which his admission to PG course will be cancelled.

#### NRI/PIO/FN Category

NRI - Non Resident Indian; PIO - Person of Indian Origin;

FN - Foreign National

An NRI is a person who is 'not a resident' or who is 'not ordinarily resident'. A person is treated as 'not ordinarily resident' (i) If he / she has been resident in India for less than 182 days in the year preceding the date of application; or (ii) If he / she has been in India for less than 365 days during the four years immediately preceding the date of application.

A PIO is a person having foreign citizenship (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) within NRI status, but who holds a foreign passport at the time of application or at the time of

consideration of admission and during the period of his / her study and whose one / both parents or anyone / both grand parent(s) is / are (or was / were), citizen(s), of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India or Section 2(b) of the Citizenship Act 1955 (Act. No. 57 of 1955).

An FN is a person having citizenship of a foreign country (any country other than India) and not having the status 'NRI' and / or 'PIO'
